

MICROSOFT SWAY for SLIDESHOWS

Some of the slideshows presented on this website are created and hosted by Microsoft using their Sway produce which is part of Microsoft Office 365. The photos used are save on a Microsoft 1-Drive account and made available to Sway. Here is one potential problem you may notice...

Your browser may show in the Sway window, "This site uses cookies..." There is no simple way to stop this. If you see one, try clicking the little arrow or two vertical bars in the sway window (if you can see them). This may "save" the cookie and stop future occurrences; or not. You may also see this on the "big" window when you open it. Here the click-on feature above should work, though it is less objectionable. When a real fix is found, this note will be updated.

The website, and Sway, are tested on the following browsers...

- Firefox (Mozilla)
- Chrome (Google)
- Edge (Microsoft)
- Vivaldi
- Opera
- Internet Explorer 11 (Microsoft) (You should consider not using IE as it is very old and not fully supported)

Sway does not work with the web browser "Safari" from Apple on Microsoft Windows. Safari is no longer supported for Windows. The last version is from 2015. It does work on the iPad and MAC. Use the same trick above for the cookie message.
